

January Row of the month

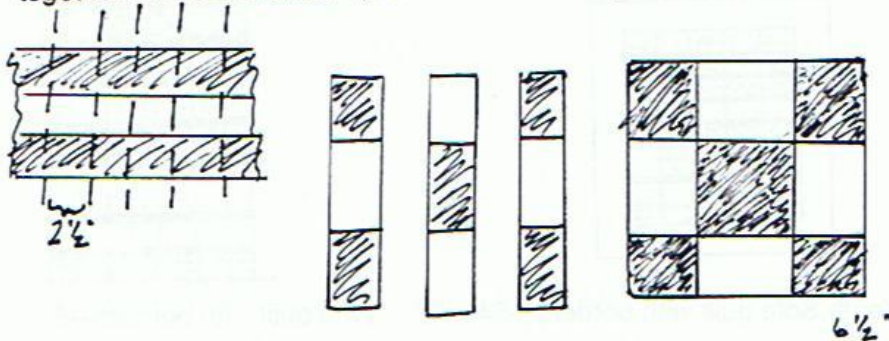
For January, you will be making nine patch blocks. These will be set together with February's blocks to make two rows.

To make eight blocks, you will need three dark strips cut across the width of fabric, and three light strips. Cut each strip $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.

Sew these together in groups of three—light, dark, light, and dark, light, dark. Press seams towards the dark strips.



Cut these strips into $2\frac{1}{2}$ " segments. Matching seams, sew three sets together to make a block. (You will have extra pieces)



Set blocks aside until next month—do not sew row together.

Baby quilt with borders: make 6 blocks
Baby quilt without borders: make 8 blocks
Youth quilt with borders: make 8 blocks
Twin quilt with borders: make 8 blocks

****Important: DO NOT THROW YOUR SCRAPS AND CUTTINGS AWAY!!!**
You will need the leftovers to make September's blocks. Save anything that is at least 1" wide.
