



## July Block of the Month

These stars are made using the directions for May's fast flying geese. They will be set together with the Hearts from June to make a row.

Each block will be 6 1/2" square, to make a finished block size of 6".

You will need a center fabric, a background fabric, and a fabric for the star points. I used a focus fabric and fussy cut motifs to fit in the center blocks.

For each block:

Cut a 3 1/2" square from the center fabric.

Cut four 2 3/8" squares for the points of the stars.

From the background fabric, cut one 4 1/4" square, and four 2" squares.

Using the 4 1/4" square of background fabric, and the 2 3/8" squares, make four fast flying geese.



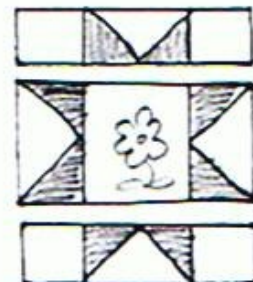
Sew a 2" background square to each side of a flying geese. Make two of these strips.



Sew two flying geese to each side of the center square.



Sew these three strips together. (like a nine patch construction.)



Sew these blocks together with June's hearts to make a row.

Baby quilt with borders: Make 3 blocks.  
 Baby quilt without borders: make 4 blocks.  
 Youth quilt: make 4 blocks.  
 Twin quilt: make 5 blocks.
